

## Fourth Time's the Charm for Jason Belmonte & Bill O'Neill in Roth-Holman PBA Doubles Championship presented by BowlerX.com

COLUMBUS, Ohio – After fourth-place finishes as partners in three previous Mark Roth-Marshall Holman PBA Doubles Championships, Australia's Jason Belmonte and his "best mate," Bill O'Neill of Langhorne, Pa., finally won in their fourth try.

With the tournament's namesake PBA Hall of Fame partners in the crowd for the finals of the event that was presented by BowlerX.com, Belmonte and O'Neill defeated brothers Darren and Michael Tang of San Francisco, 205-185, at Wayne Webb's Columbus Bowl. The finals of the fourth event of the 2018 Go Bowling! PBA Tour season aired Sunday on ESPN.

After a dominating performance in the preliminary qualifying rounds where they averaged a combined 238.31 for 76 games, earning the top berth in the finals by 327 pins, Belmonte and O'Neill finished in convincing style. The win was the 17th of Belmonte's ca-

reer and the ninth for O'Neill. The championship came down to age-and-experience out-matching the youthful exuberance of third-year PBA member Darren Tang, 24, and his 22-year-old brother Michael, a PBA Tour rookie.

O'Neill and Belmonte threw only four strikes in the title match – including one double – and converted six single-pin spares. It was enough to stave off the Tangs, who had won three consecutive matches

# Just Paying Attention

In the first of a two-part interview last week, Brian Menini, bowling proprietor, PBA regional titlist, and computer programmer explained his new complete tournament web page, [ibowltournaments.com](http://ibowltournaments.com). This week, Menini discusses more specific functions his tournament database for both tournament organizers and bowlers.

JPA: Explain what the [ibowltournaments.com](http://ibowltournaments.com) can do besides list tournaments (record keeping, etc) and how it is different than tournament group pages on Facebook?

Menini: Here's what it can do for tournaments.

1) Allow you to enter your entire schedule for all tournaments - The site sorts tournaments by dates, distance and user preferences for distances so they will see the upcoming tournaments first based on distance.

2) The site will send reminders to bowlers based on their preferences, It also reminds the person running the tournament to upload results to the site so all bowlers can see them easily.

3) You can copy tournaments so if you run more than one, it makes data entry easier,

even uploading your flyer for the tournament to the site.

If you don't have a flyer, the site can generate a very basic one for now off the data you entered for the tournament.

4) Upload results to the tournament, You get notified every time someone adds your tournament to their calendar or removes it so you know who is planning on coming to your tournament without all the notes back and forth.

5) It also checks as you enter the tournament within a certain mileage range 30-60-90 miles (Your choice) to see if anything else is scheduled for that day nearby to attempt to avoid competing events.

The site also auto archives all tournaments so they will drop off the upcoming events and calendars when they are completed.

6) Users can follow tournaments, hosts, or bowling centers.

To access users coming to your tournament just click on MyTournaments, then select show my tournaments, then click the link under the details and you will see a list of bowlers that have added your tournament to their calendar.

You can add a secondary

admin to enter tournaments and upload flyers, results, etc

Now for bowlers it will do the following:

1) Allow all bowlers to create calendars of events they are interested in with the click of a button. That includes viewing details about the tournament, flyer, results.

2) Ability to enter notes about the tournament. Some examples include balls used, scores, notes about lanes, center, what balls didn't work there or anything you can think of. You can access these later so if it is an annual event, you can look back to see how you did, what worked and what didn't, etc.

3) Ability to upload files, including photos to create memories from the tournaments. Input stats, screenshots from your favorite stats program if you use one, or anything else you can think of

You can enter profit and loss info, including tournament, travel, sidepots, brackets, clothing, Equipment, Food. The site will calculate your profit and loss and include that on the history report for your tournaments so you will always know your financial status regarding tournaments. You can also share your notes on Facebook from the site.

4) In the android app, you can go into the tournament and get directions with the touch of a button using google maps.

5) You can follow Tournaments, hosts, and centers to be notified when they enter new events. There is also an internal messaging system that will allow you to contact other bowlers to see if they are bowling as well.

JPA: A techy question, what were the challenges of creating an iOS app and an android app for the webpage?

Menini: In our case it was planning, there is a lot of information to pack into a small screen space. Design is hard to get right, I think we have done a good job, I am sure there are things that will need some tweaks to make the

user experience better, and I will address those as they show themselves.

I am a bowler, and would love to bowl every weekend. I as most bowlers, get annoyed when there are three tournaments in one weekend and nothing for three weeks after that.

The next feature is how many television stations these days simultaneously use traditional and interactive social media even at a time of the day when bowling rarely occurs.

Recent Barabso PBA Players Championship winner Tom Smallwood was featured on its ABC12 Morning Show, rolling a few shots down the lane in both the 5:00 am and 6:00 am hours, highlighting his recent tour success, and plug his upcoming appearance in the USBC Masters in April.


Morning field reporter Marc Jacobson joined up with Smalls at Cilo Bowling Arcade, highlighting his career, even asking about the impromptu application of Barbasol shaving cream on his face after the last title.

After the 5:00 am hour live on-air segment, Jacobson took to Facebook Live to plug the 6:00 am segment, then asked Smallwood to see how many strikes he could roll while reading Facebook comments as Tom bowled. After the 6:00 am hour live on-air segment, Smallwood threw more shots and answered Facebook Live questions asked for by Jacobson.

Answering questions in real time on Facebook Live is not new, as we see on PBA XtraFrame coverage, but doing it while on-the-air in real time is becoming more and more the norm for local television news coverage.



51) Prior to the 1974 PBA Midas Open finals, a lane breakdown forced the PBA to use lanes from non-adjointing pairs for the finals. In the second game, Jim Stefanich threw the PBA's third perfect game on TV, the first and only time that feat occurred. Dick Ritger won the title, but Stefanich won a \$10,000 bonus plus a new Lincoln-Mercury Cougar.

52) At age 57, John Handegard defeated Mark Williams, 278-247, to win the 1995 PBA Northwest Classic in Kennewick, Wash., becoming the oldest player to win a PBA Tour title.

53) Michael Haugen Jr. overcame a 53-pin deficit through six frames to win the 2008 PBA Tournament of Champions, 215-214, over Chris Barnes at Red Rock Lanes in Las Vegas. Haugen's five-strike rally forced Barnes to get 20 pins in the 10th to force a tie. After converting a spare, Barnes left the 4 pin on his last shot.



lane, the Tang brothers came out of the gate on fire, putting together a string of six strikes early on their way to a 223-203 win over Texans Shawn Maldonado and DJ Archer in game one. Splits and open frames in the final two frames by the Tangs were the only flaws that kept the score close in the end.

In game two, Brandon Novak of Chillicothe, Ohio, and Kris Prather of Plainfield, Ill., looked like they were

going to eliminate the brother team when they put together a string of five early strikes. But the Tangs started with three strikes, converted two single-pin spares and combined for three strikes to take the seesaw battle into the 10th frame where Michael Tang doubled and Prather, after a strike on his first ball, left a 10 pin on his second. The Tangs escaped with a 243-235 decision.

The semifinal contest against two of the PBA's top high-rev power players, Marshall Kent of Yakima, Wash., and EJ Tackett of Huntington,

Ind., was a struggle for both teams as they quickly degraded an oil pattern that had already undergone the wear-and-tear of two earlier matches. Kent was especially vulnerable, throwing three consecutive splits he was unable to convert. Michael Tang also failed to convert a split, but otherwise the brothers left single pins they were able to spare in posting a 172-151 win to advance to the title match.

PBA players now head to Syracuse, N.Y., where the 2018 Go Bowling! PBA Tour continues with the United States Bowling Congress Masters. As defending champion, Belmonte is automatically seeded into the 64-player three-game total pin-fall double-elimination match play finals field and will try for an unprecedented fifth Masters title. 

“The PBA has been searching for the best possible broadcast partner to serve our fans, players and the bowling industry, and we have determined that partner is FOX Sports,” Clark said. “We are particularly excited that the PBA Tour returns to broadcast television, where it started 56 years ago, with shows on FOX next year.”

In 2019, FOX Sports will televise four PBA Tour shows on FOX and 25 on FS1 in a series of two-hour telecasts. All programs will also be streamed on FOX Sports GO. Details pertaining to the FOX Sports-PBA package regarding PBA Tour locations, dates and times, and the television announcing team will be released at a later date.

“FOX Sports is thrilled to add the highly rated PBA Tour to our extensive lineup, joining other sport partners including the NFL, the FIFA World Cup, MLB, NASCAR, MLS, UFC, NHRA, Supercross, USGA, college football and basketball, and others,” said Wanger. “We believe that adding a FOX Sports look and feel to bowling will help bring the sport to a whole new level.”


