OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entry is open to all member of USBC. This tournament will be certified by the USBC and conducted under the rules and regulations of the USBC.
2. All bowlers must be sanctioned and in good standing with the USBC.
3. Tournament will consist of 5 member teams and must have at least one male and one female member.
4. Average rule: Bowlers will use their highest book average in last two(2) seasons, 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 yearbook average. If highest average in last two seasons is more than 10 pins less than highest yearbook average in last five(5) seasons dating back to 2006-2007 yearbook, then bowlers must use the median of the two averages. ex. 2010-2011 avg. 190. 2007-2008 avg 210. Bowler would use 200 average. All averages will be verified by the tournament committee.
5. If bowler has no average in the last two seasons, then highest book average in last five seasons will be used, dating back to 2006-2007 yearbook.
6. No sport league, Red, White & Blue league, NABI, or any other average not conducted on house condition may be used.
7. If no average other than sport in last five seasons, then sport average will be used and adjusted according to USBC average scale.
8. If no average at all in last five seasons, bowler must be sanctioned and a 225 average will be used.
9. IT WILL BE THE BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE. FAILURE TO USE THE CORRECT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORES, IF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN THE CORRECT AVERAGE THEREBY RESULTING IN MORE HANDICAP.
10. Handicap will be based on team average, 90% of 1100. 90% of 220 will be used for individuals for brackets and sidepot purposes.
11. Entry must be paid in full prior to the beginning of the tournament.
12. Entries may be mailed in, no later than August 12th.
13. On site entries will be CASH ONLY.
14. 100% of prize fees will be returned to participants in prize money.
15. In the event of ties, there will be prize money shared equally in the cashing position. If there is a tie for first place, the money will be shared equally and co-champions will be named.
16. The tournament committee shall have the authority to decide any other matters pertaining to the operations of the tournament not covered by the above rules.
